

SSC Constable GD Exam Syllabus / Pattern 2025

Short Information: This year the SSC has changed the online Computer-based examination exam pattern for SSC GD constable recruitment. Now there will be 20 questions from each of the subjects of General Intelligence and Reasoning, General Knowledge and General Awareness, Elementary Mathematics, and English / Hindi. Each subject will have 20 questions with two marks for each correct answer, and the duration of the exam is 60 minutes.

Written Exam Syllabus

General Intelligence and Reasoning: This section will test the candidate's analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns. Questions will be based on topics such as analogies, similarities, differences, spatial visualization, visual memory, discrimination, arithmetical reasoning, coding, decoding, etc.

General Knowledge and General Awareness: Questions will focus on testing the candidate's general

awareness about the environment and current events. Topics include sports, history, culture, geography, economic scene, Indian polity, Indian constitution, and scientific research.

Elementary Mathematics: The mathematics section will include questions on number systems, computation, decimals, percentages, ratio and proportion, averages, interest, profit and loss, mensuration, time and distance, etc.

English / Hindi: This section will test the candidate's basic understanding and comprehension of English or Hindi language.
